



Other then usual webinars or video presentations our meetings are rather complex. They are:


- Highly interactive

- Frequent and weighted voting at the General Assembly




In order to accommodate for those circumstances the Executive Committee has recommended a number of modifications from our usual procedure and schedules:
With the global spread of attendees – to limit session time to 3 hours per day
To use a conference system which best allows the use of four languages during the online conference
To concentrate on those matters of work, which are statutorily necessary or have a high chance to be adopted
To use software that permits designated Delegates and Council Members to cast their votes












Presidential Election

- Dr Heidi Stensmyren will stand to be accepted by acclamation as President-Elect at the General Assembly on 30 October.














Voting with NemoVote I



- During our sessions when motions are being put to the vote, the Chair usually asks who is in favour and who is against and he or she may ask for abstentions.
- In order to save time during the online sessions the Chair may reverse the order and ask the Council Members (in Council or Committee) or the designated voting delegates for objections first. At this point only attendees allowed to vote may speak. If there is no objection, the motion is accepted, if there is and the opposition cannot be cleared immediately, the Chair will start the online <u>voting with NemoVote</u>.
